Lord, whether my husband turns to the right or to the left, let his ears hear your voice behind him, saying, "This is the way; walk in it."




Isaiah 30:21

Let my husband have no fear of bad news; may his heart be steadfast, trusting in You LORD.




Psalms 112:7

Psalm 23:4


