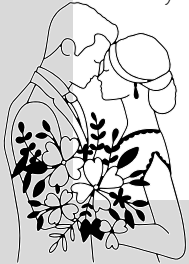


I have not stopped giving thanks for you husband,

for us who believe.



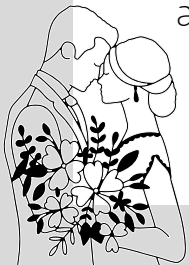
Ephesians 1:16-19

do not give up.



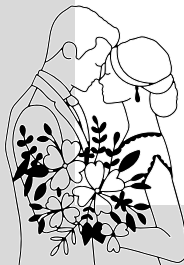
Galatians 6:9

and slow to become angry,



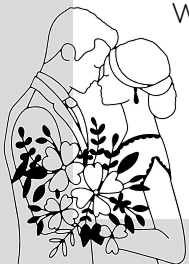

straight.



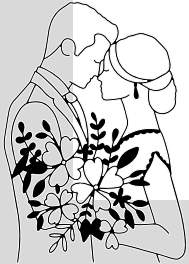
Proverbs 3:5-6

of his hands.



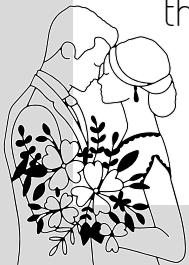
Psalms 90:17

Christ Jesus.



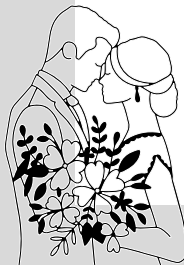
Philippians 4:7

Redeemer.



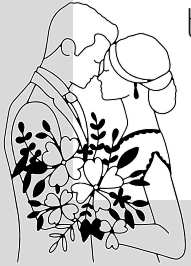
Psalms 19:14

as he trusts in you.



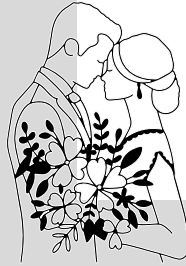
Isaiah 26:3

more.



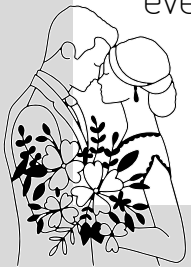
Deuteronomy 33:11

"This is the way; walk in it."



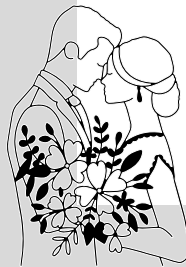
Isaiah 30:21

everything you want him to do.



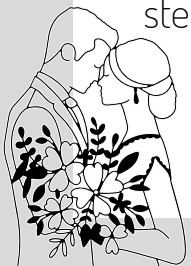
Acts 13:22

make it obedient to Christ.



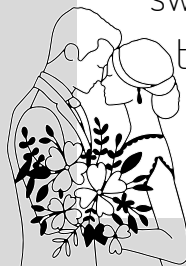
2 Corinthians 10:5

pursuing dishonest gain.



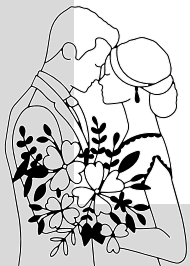
Titus 1:7

never be shaken.



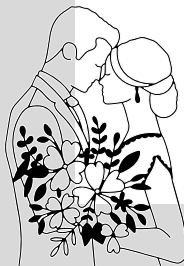
Psalms 15:2-5

presence forever.



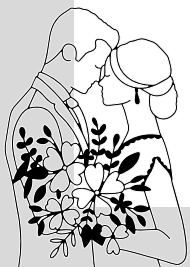
Psalms 41:11-12
